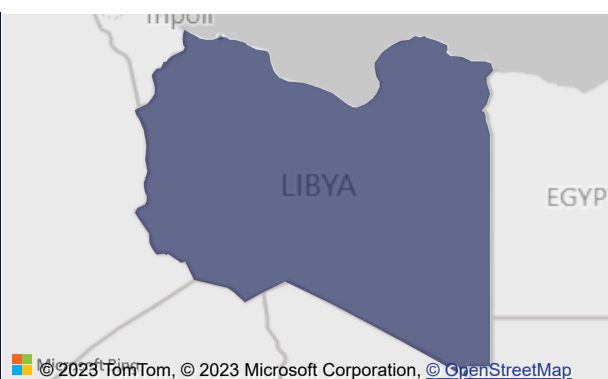


## Key Actions

1. Protection from Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (PSEA) Network in Libya, co-chaired by UNFPA and UNICEF, achieves progress in addressing SEA within humanitarian community.
2. Work plan focuses on PSEA structure, prevention, reporting mechanisms, and victims' assistance.
3. Achievements include awareness campaigns, safe reporting mechanisms, and survivor-centered approach training.
4. Online training initiative covers various PSEA topics, engaging over 50 participants from 20 organizations.
