## **Key Actions**

1. Protection from Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (PSEA) activities reached 18,596 people via 40 network members, spanning policy, advocacy, and risk assessments.

2. Gedaref State PSEA group, led by UNHCR, integrates PSEA into Eastern Sudan refugee response.

3. A new West Darfur State group formed, trained by UNFPA, holding monthly meetings chaired by UNICEF.


4. Unique 5-day certified SEA Investigations training held in Khartoum with UNICEF and UNFPA, aimed at building investigative capacity among Sudanese national NGOs.




