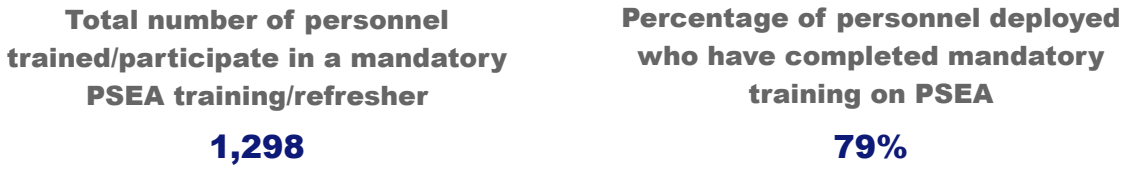

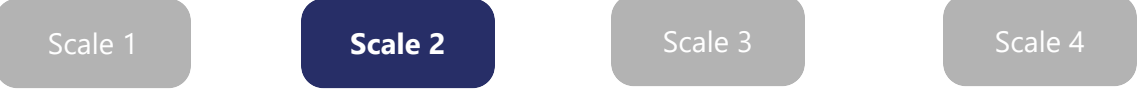
Status of SEA Risk assessment

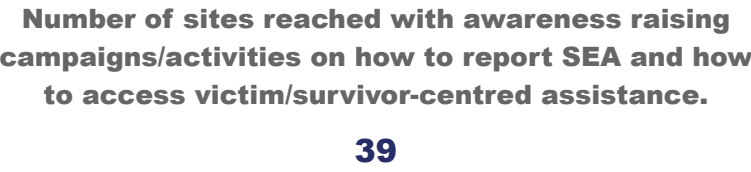
Access to a safe and accessible channel to report SEA

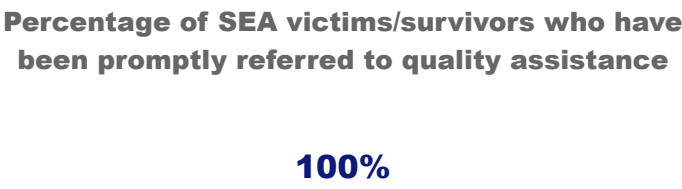


Number of site where awareness raising campaigns on reporting

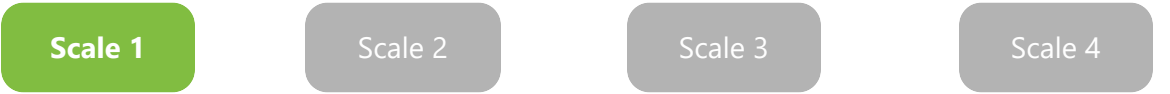

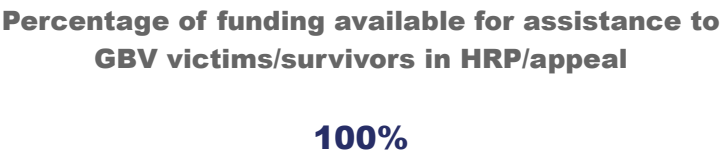


Status of implementation of the UN Victims' Assistance Protocol by the PSEA Network



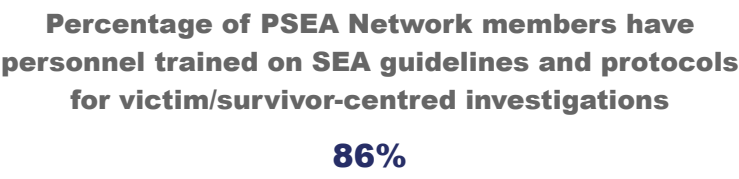

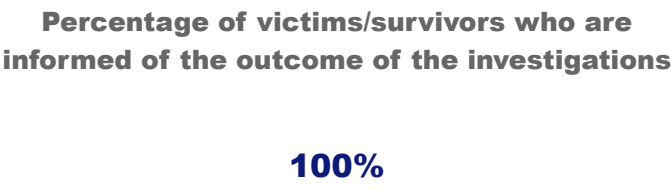
