

# Sexual exploitation and abuse are always wrong

**Sexual abuse** is when a powerful person makes a less powerful person have sex. It can happen by force, or using unfair control.

**Sexual exploitation** is when a powerful person gets sex for something a less powerful person needs.

The **United Nations** (UN) is an organisation made up of many countries working together. It works to make the world a safer and better place.



#### **Zero Tolerance**

**Zero Tolerance** means something is never allowed.



UN staff are never allowed to do sexual abuse or sexual exploitation.



If an aid worker does sexual abuse or sexual exploitation, they will have to leave their job.



#### No excuse

Being sexual to a child under 18 is always wrong.



Please do not stay quiet if an aid worker does any sexual act with you.



The UN does not allow any sexual acts from aid workers.



## **Beneficiaries**

**Beneficiaries** are the people the UN supports.



Aid workers must not be sexual to beneficiaries.



Please speak up if an aid worker does a sexual act with you.



# Paying for sex

All aid is free.



Aid workers must not ask for sex in return for any aid.



If this happens to you, please speak up.



# Do the right thing

If you know someone has been sexually exploited or abused, please speak up.

This may save the life of the survivor.



### Tell us

Remember, any sexual exploitation or abuse against you is never your fault.



Please tell us if you think UN staff or an aid worker is doing sexual exploitation or abuse.

We may also:


• Stop them from working for the UN in the future.


