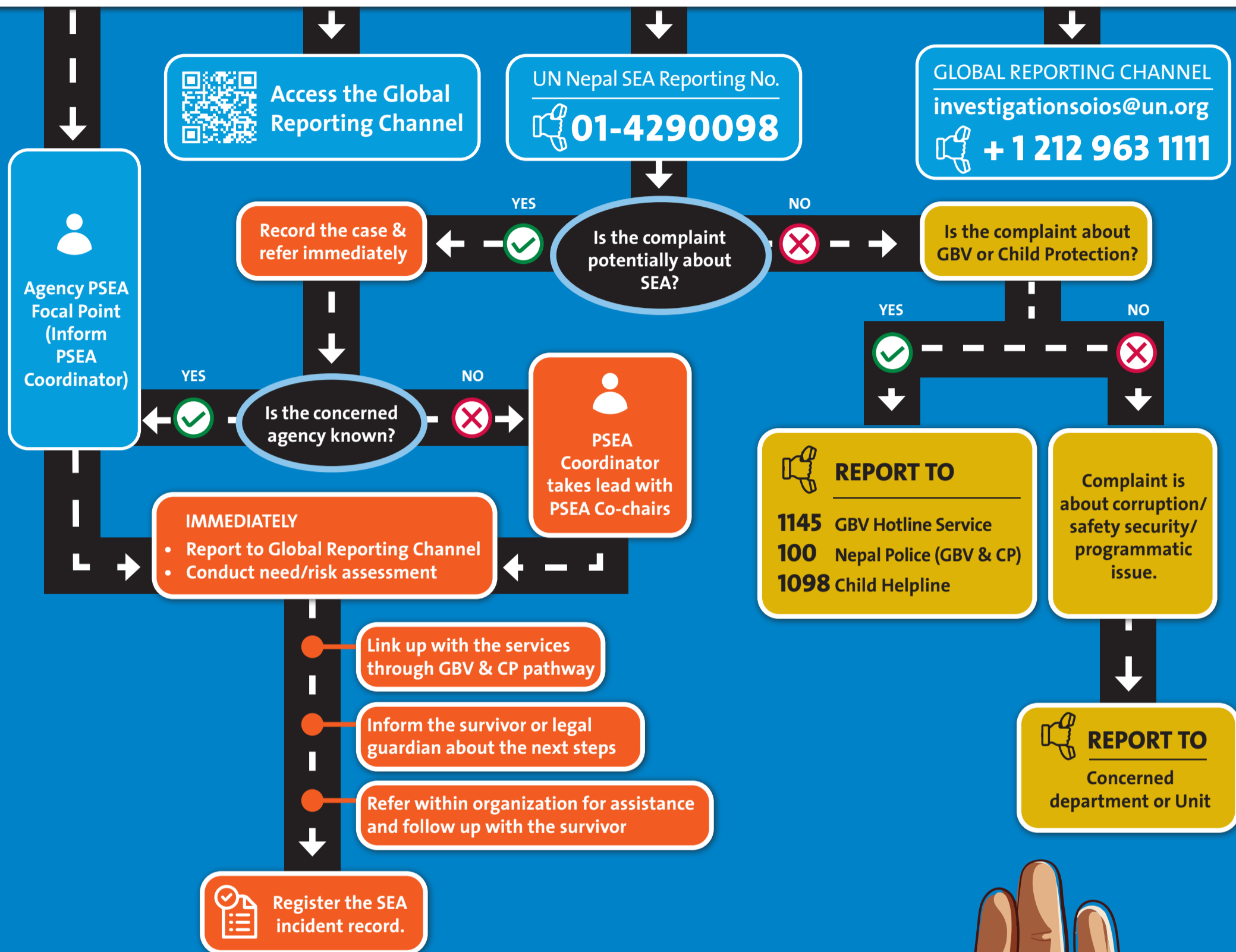


Sexual Exploitation & Abuse (SEA) Incident Reporting & Responding Flow Chart for UN Nepal

WHERE TO REPORT SEA INCIDENT ?



Who can report an SEA complaint ?

- Victim/survivor or their family members
- Local GBV or other service providers
- Community members/stakeholders
- Others
- UN personnel
- Partner organisation/staff

Must report incidents of SEA if they are aware of, have observed, or suspect such behavior. Failure to report the incident constitutes a breach of the UN standards of conduct.



Abbreviations:

- PSEA – Protection from Sexual Exploitation and Abuse
- SEA – Sexual Exploitation and Abuse
- GBV – Gender-based Violence
- CP – Child Protection
- OIOS/IOS - Office of Internal Oversight Services

Note: All UN agencies require to share the allegations of SEA related to UN personnel & implementing partner personnel with the Resident Coordinator.
