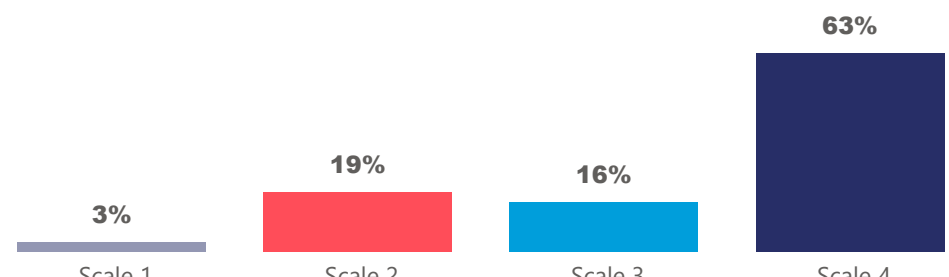


This global dashboard is based on 32 countries/territories that have responded to 2023 IASC Mapping Exercise.



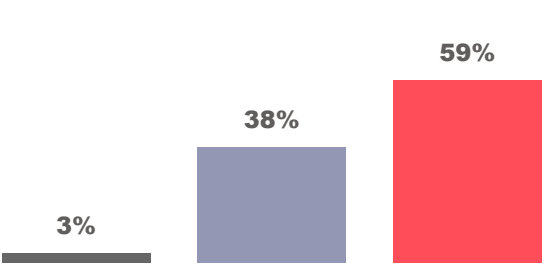
Coordination

Status of Inter-Agency PSEA Network



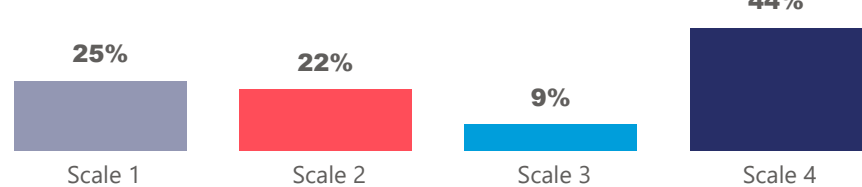
Scale 1: PSEA Network has not been formally established.
Scale 2: PSEA Network is established with endorsed Terms of Reference, representation from United Nations Country Team/Humanitarian Country Team members, INGOs/NGOs and clear Network roles and responsibilities.
Scale 3: PSEA Network has a budgeted Action Plan in place.
Scale 4: PSEA Network is fully operational.

The United Nations Country Team/Humanitarian Country Team fulfils its functions



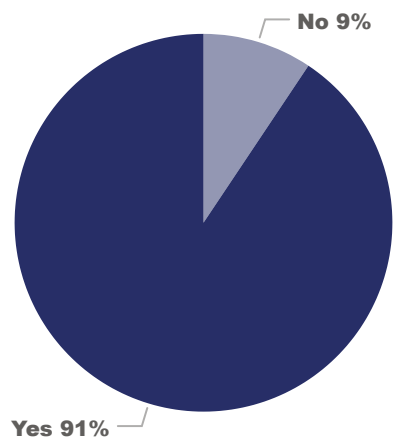
Scale 1: The United Nations Country Team/Humanitarian Country Team has partially fulfilled its core functions as the senior-level body accountable for PSEA

Status of PSEA Coordinator (as of Dec 2023)

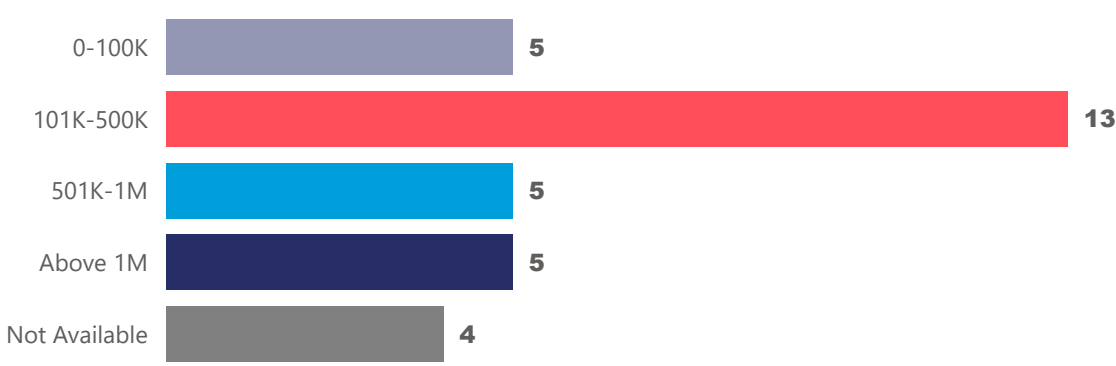


Scale 1: There is no inter-agency PSEA Coordinator in the country

Inter-Agency PSEA Action Plan budgeted for the following year



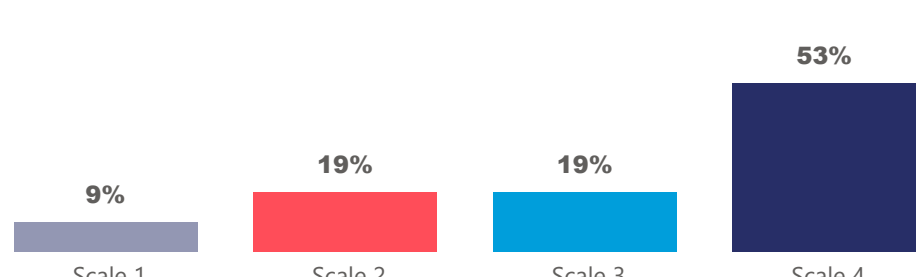
Number of countries with requested budget for Inter-Agency PSEA activities for the following year



Number of countries with % of budget allocated for the following year

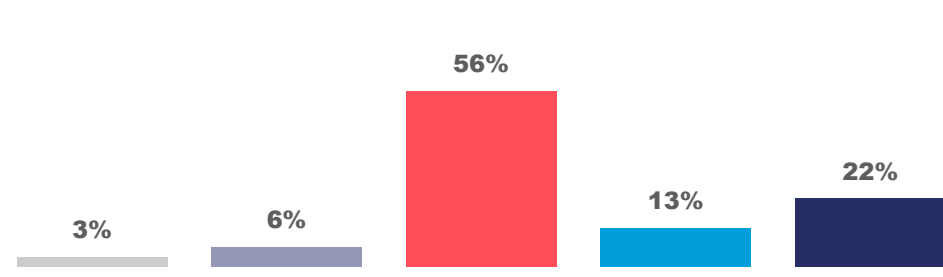


Status of the PSEA Network's coordination



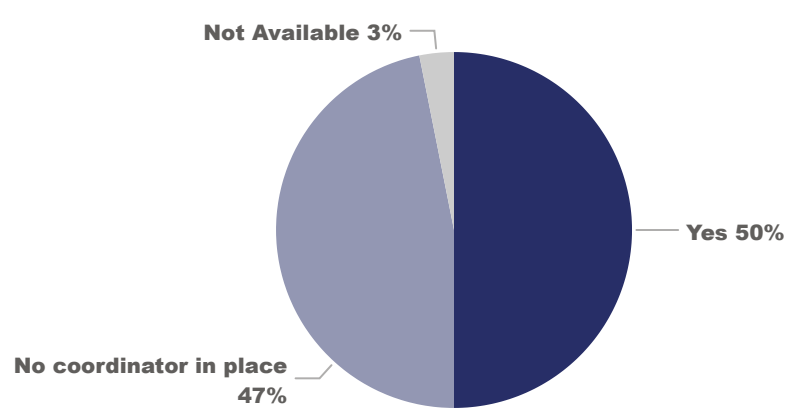
Scale 1: There is neither PSEA Coordinator nor Co-chair in place

Status of integration of PSEA into Humanitarian Response Plan

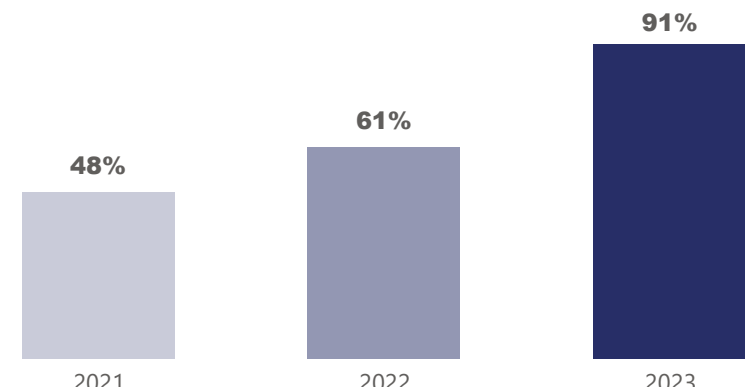


Scale 1: The HRP does not integrate PSEA

Scale 4: HRP monitoring framework includes inter-sector-level PSEA indicators

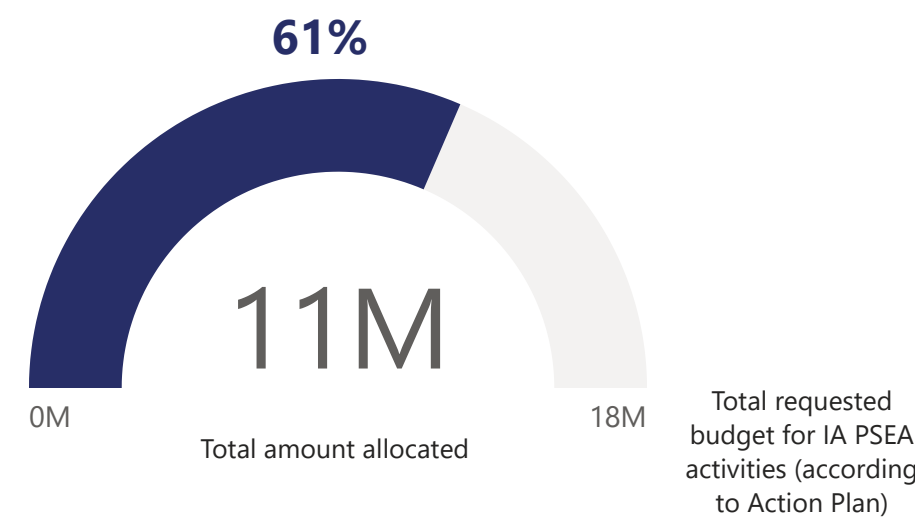
PSEA coordinator reports directly to the Resident /Humanitarian Coordinator (RC/HC)



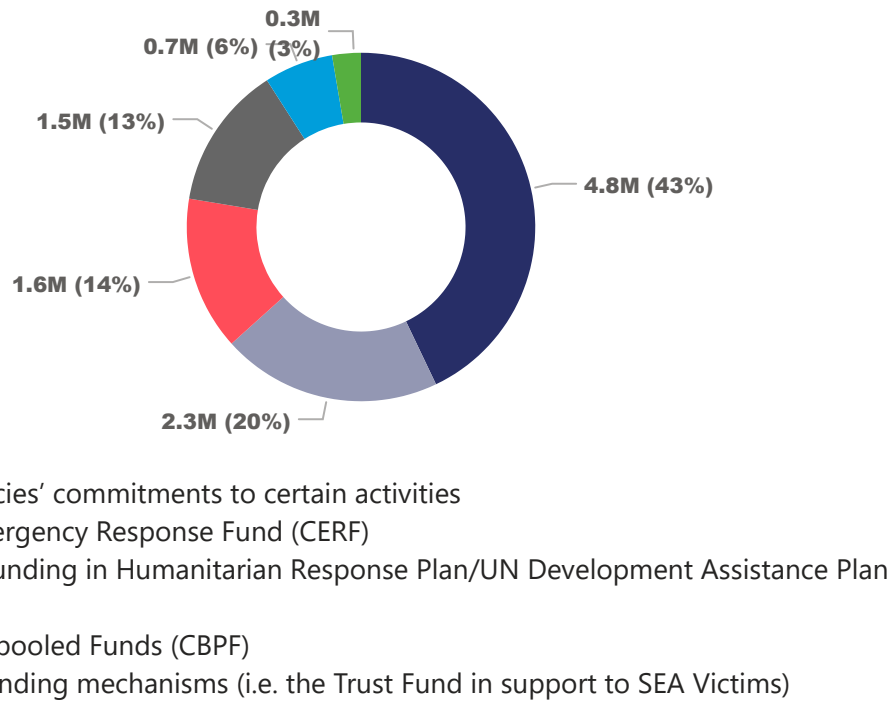
Percentage of Inter-Agency PSEA Action Plans budgeted, by year



Funding status overview for the following year

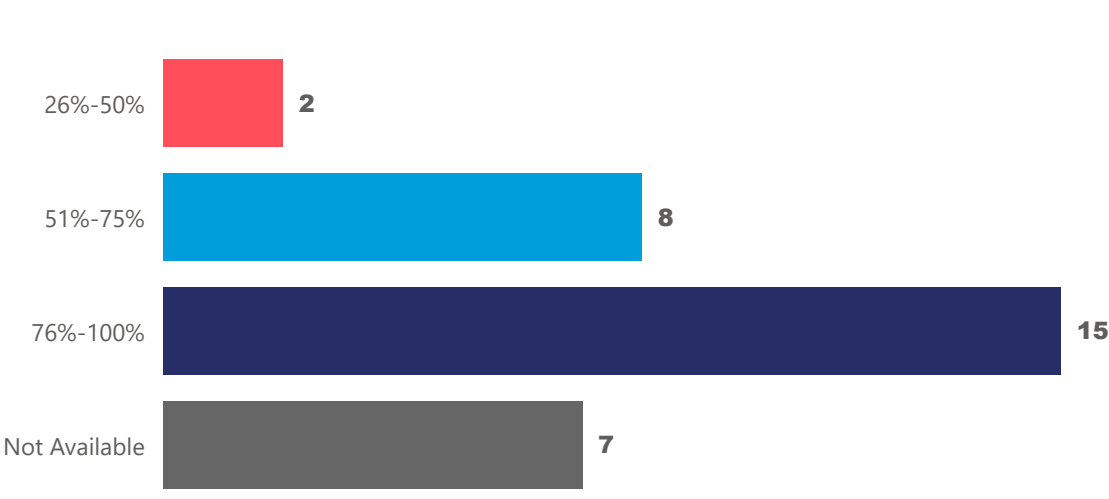


Budget allocated for the following year, by source

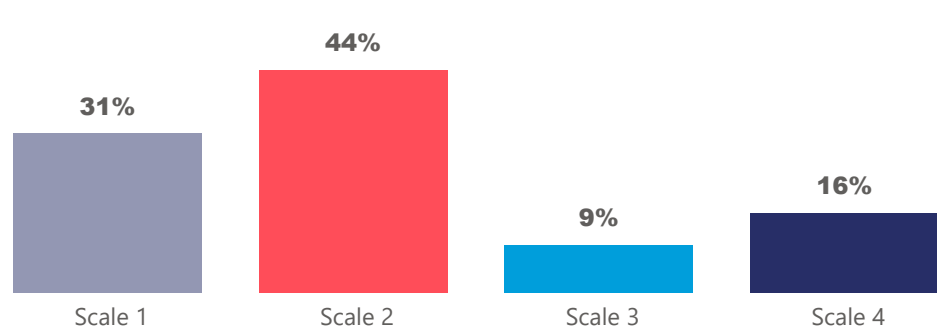

Status of Inter-Agency SEA risk assessment

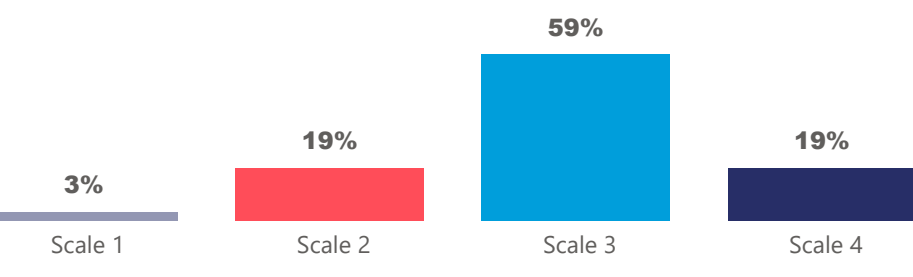


Scale 1: There has been no evaluation/assessment of any type carried out on SEA risks

Scale 4: Findings from the assessment have been presented to UNCT/HCT and have informed strategies and the Action Plan



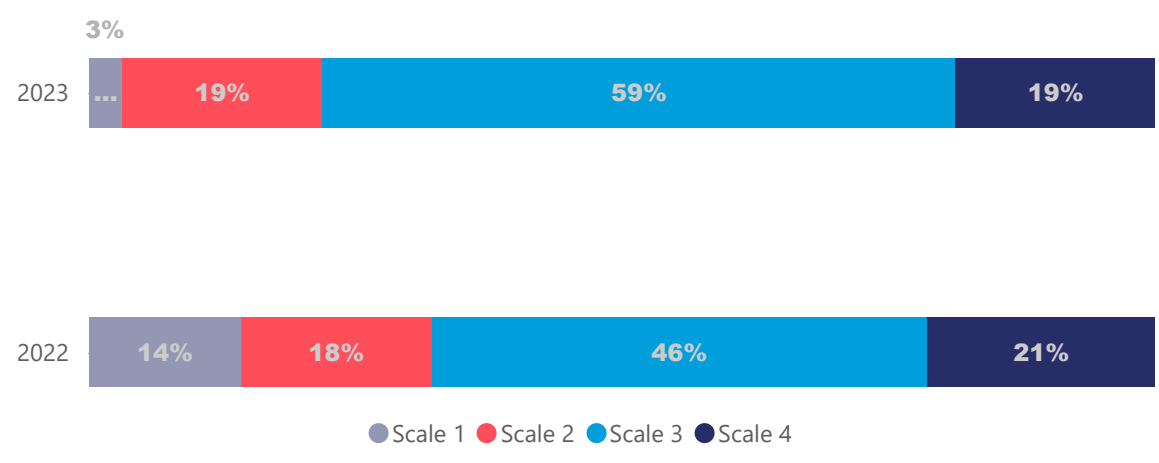

Status of Inter-Agency PSEA Standard Operating Procedures

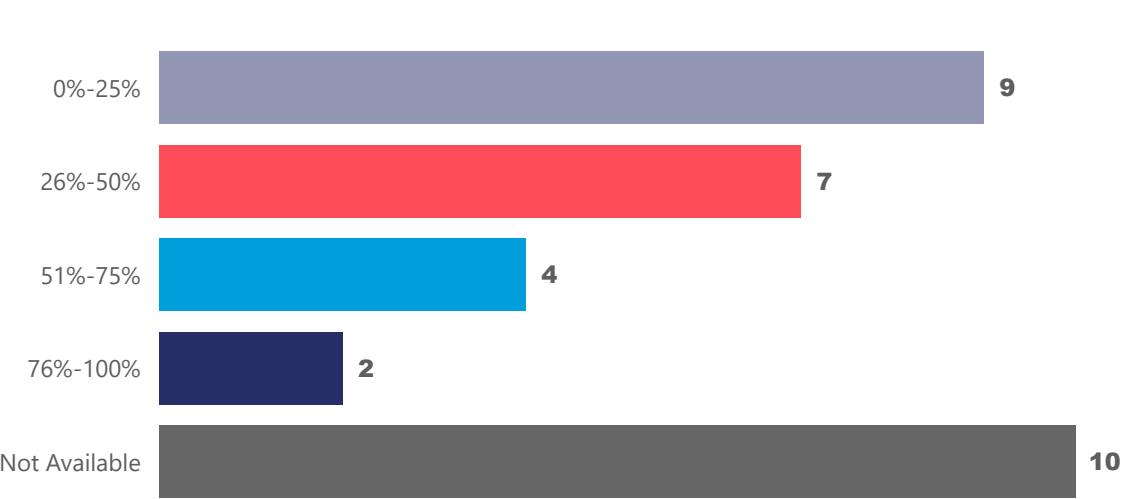


Scale 1: SOPs are nonexistent

Number of countries with % of population who have access to a safe and accessible channel to report SEA

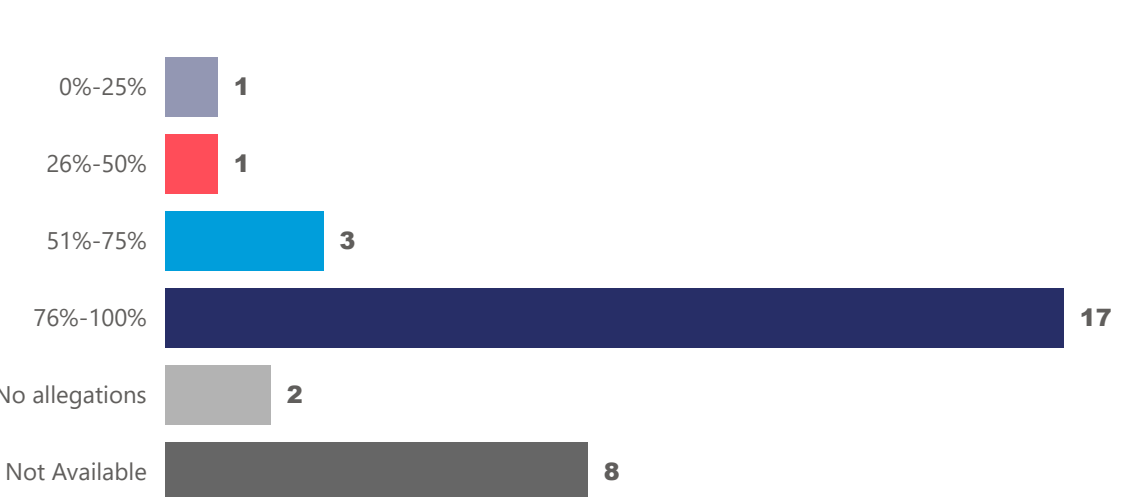


Number of countries with % of allegations reported to the PSEA Network and promptly responded to

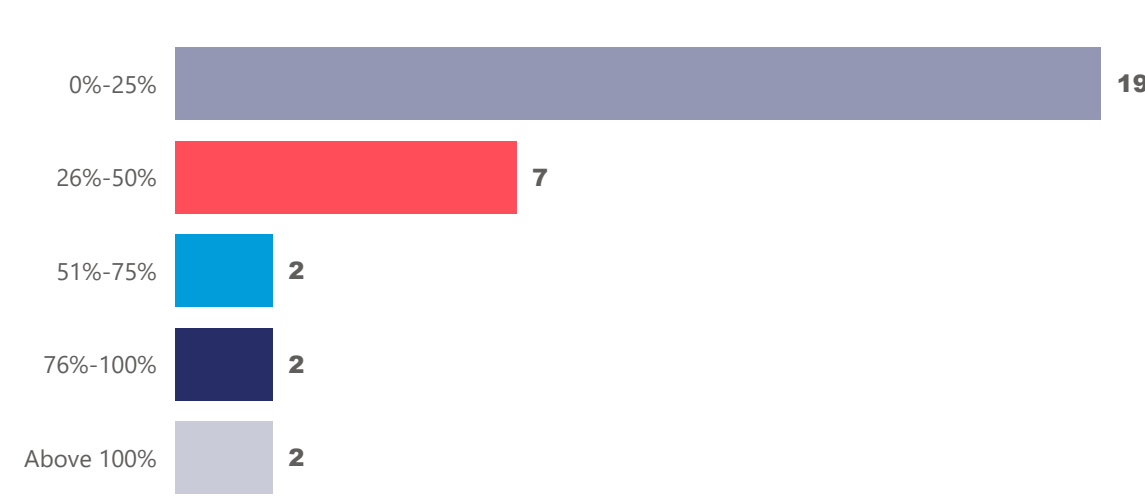

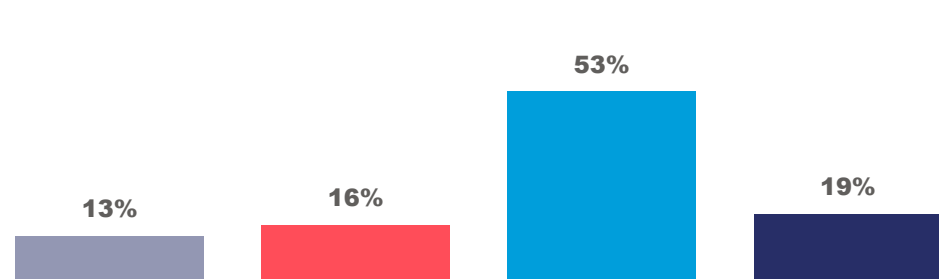
Number of countries with % of SEA victims/survivors who have been promptly referred to quality assistance



Number of countries with % of GBV sector needs covered in HRP/appeal

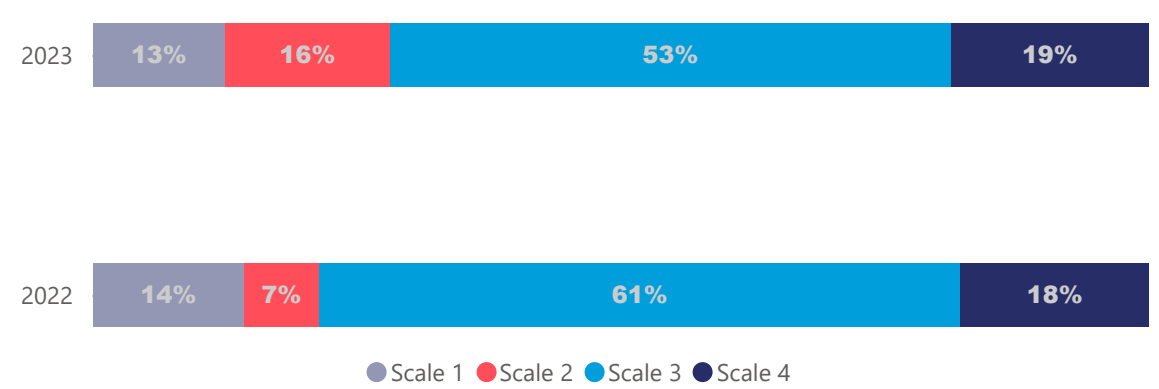


Status of implementation of the UN Victim Assistance Protocol by the PSEA Network



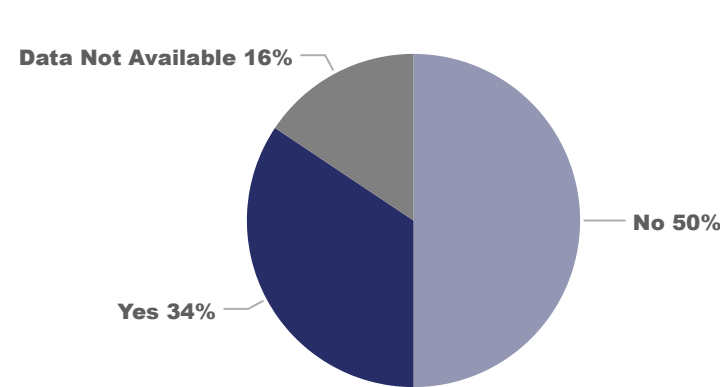
Scale 1: SOPs are nonexistent.

Status of implementation of the UN Victim Assistance Protocol by the PSEA Network, by year

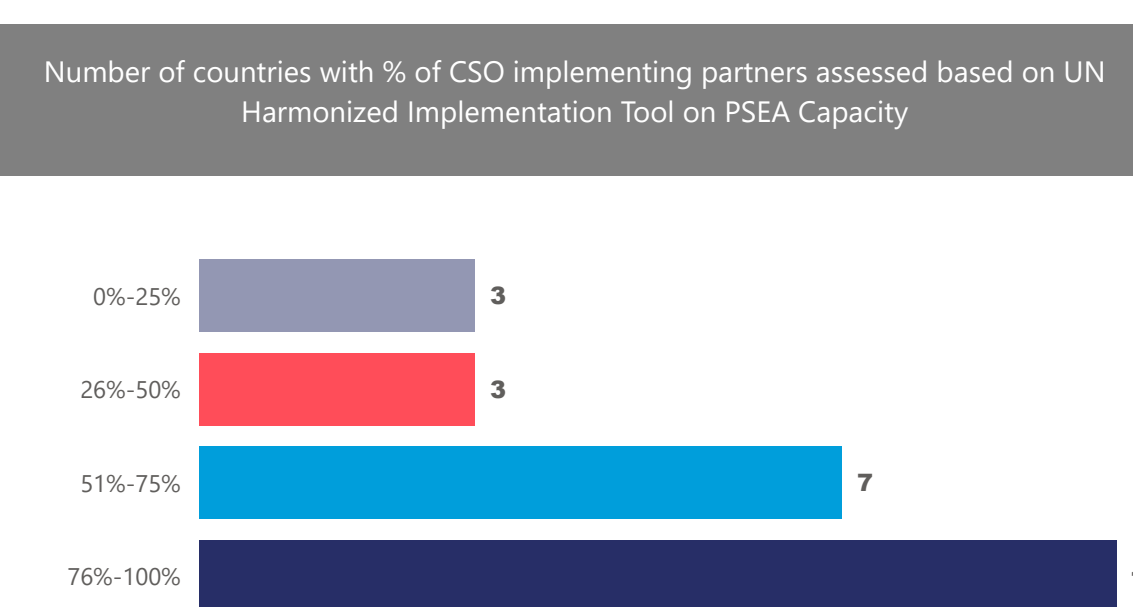

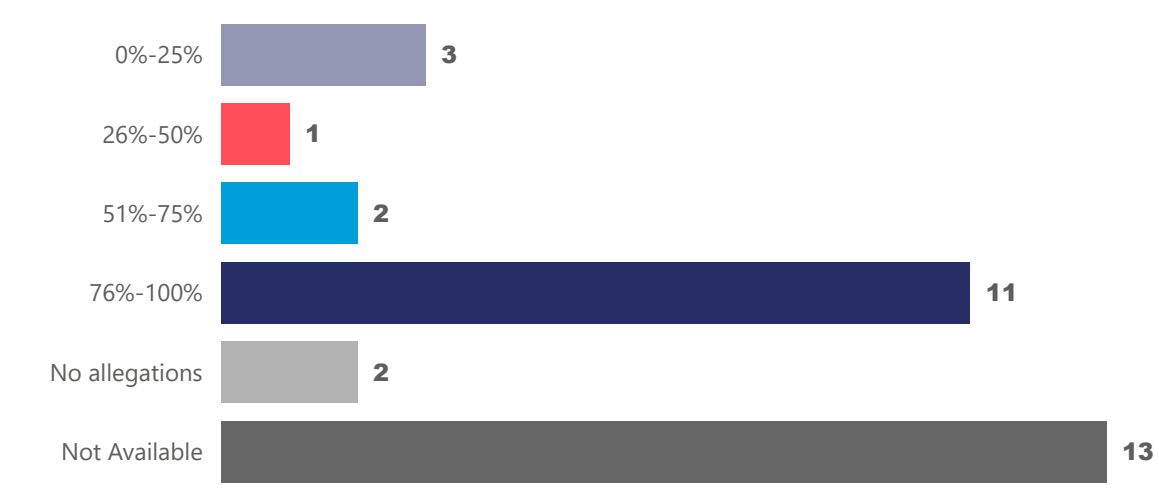
Countries with local investigators trained on SEA for victim-centred & trauma-informed investigation



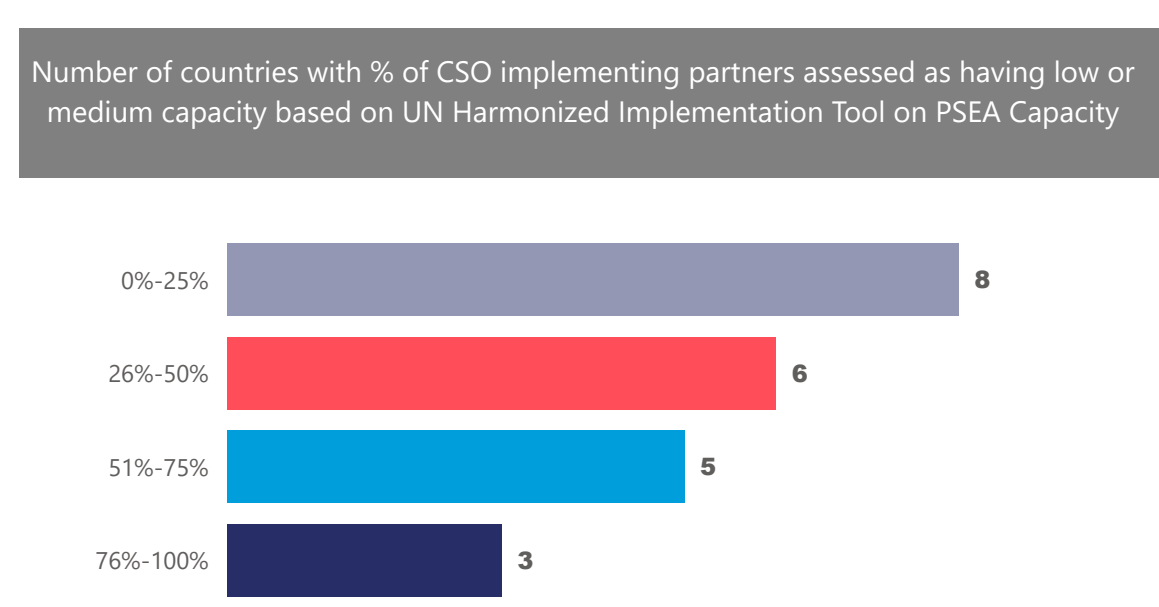
Number of countries with % of CSO implementing partners assessed based on UN Harmonized Implementation Tool on PSEA Capacity
